ALL OVER FENCE CLASSES AND PLEASURE DRIVING MUST BE PRE-ENTERED BY 1 JULY 2011 and COURSE FEE and STALL FEE (\$60 Total) are due, classes not having 3+ entries will be cancelled before the show starts. Courses will be in Outdoor Arena – First show will start Friday 3 PM and second show will be Saturday starting at 5PM.

TWO YEAR OLD WESTERN PLEASURE WILL PRECEDE GREEN WESTERN PLEASURE

CLASS FEES:

Single class fee = \$15 per class per judge for Open, AM/ Select and Youth
\$12 per class per judge for Nov AM and Nov Youth

Circuit Fees = OPEN, AM/SELECT AND YOUTH
-\$60/ JUDGE for more than 4 classes = \$240 for 4 Judges

NOV AM OR YOUTH
- \$48/ JUDGE for more than 4 classes = \$192 for 4 Judges

Novice Horses crossing-over into AM/Select or Youth will be charged an additional \$6/class, no additional office or other fees. All entries crossing over into JR, SR or All Age classes will be charged an additional \$10/class, no office or other fees.

There will be a \$10/day course fee for ALL horses entered in TRAIL or any FENCE class.
AQHA Admin fee = \$5/horse/Judge = \$20 per circuit

All Breed Classes 13&U W/T = \$6/class

NO OFFICE FEE FOR EARLY ENTRIES (CLOSE ONE WEEK BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF EACH CIRCUIT) = **FRIDAY APR 15, FRIDAY JUN 17, and FRIDAY JUL 8th**
LATE ENTRIES = \$5/horse/Judge = \$20 for Circuit no matter how many or few classes

PRE-Entry only requires basic horse/rider info for at least one class, other classes can be added at show- USE NMQHA WEB ENTRY, FAX OR REGULAR E-MAIL

PRE-ENTRIES FOR CLASSES 19-120 do NOT require any pre-payments.

**Stalls = \$25/horse or tack/ night OR \$40 for Circuit = Friday and Saturday
HORSES STAYING SUNDAY to MONDAY or coming in on THURSDAY will be charged additional \$20/night. Haul-Ins = \$15/horse/day must remain at the trailer- no day stalls, horses must be tied to trailers or be ridden. Haul-Ins may NOT use catch-pens by IHA or Outdoor Arena.**

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

Breaks will be determined by show management at each show, but there will be time between classes to accommodate tack and attire changes. If you need extra time advise the Paddock Master- gate will routinely be held only 2 mins.

ENTER AND RESERVE STALLS ELECTRONICALLY ON THE NMQHA WEBSITE- www.nmqha.com
ENTER EARLY- call, e-mail or do electronically, DO NOT SEND MONEY.

RULES: The shows will be governed by AQHA rules, only AQHA rules will prevail. **EXCEPT FOR ALL BREED CLASSES-** Every exhibitor, rider, and owner(s) must be members of AQHA. Every horse must be registered with AQHA and have current ownership designated on papers or have filed Lease agreements with AQHA. Novice riders (Youth and AM) can ride any horse owned by anyone- no lease agreements necessary.

STALLS: Stalls are 10X10 metal or cinderblock. The metal stalls are fully enclosed with full bottom and grilled or solid top dutch doors. The cinderblock stalls have 1/2 wall fronts with only a bottom door (not suitable for stallions). All have portal covers- limited tack rooms available. Tack rooms should NOT be considered secured even when padlocks are applied.

Parking is NOT allowed in front of stalls except while unloading. RV parking is available on the grounds.

SHAVINGS: Available from the on-site feed store, along with hay. Check NMQHA website for contact number. Payment must be made to the feed store DIRECTLY, shavings and feed WILL NOT BE applied to show bills.

SECURITY: NMQHA assumes no responsibility for losses, damages or thefts. Expo provides security to the grounds but do NOT assume vehicles, horses, personal belongings are safe. Secure all valuables and lock purses up OUT OF SIGHT.

DRUG TESTING: All AQHA horses will be subject to drug testing according to AQHA program. A licensed, on-site veterinarian will provide required services.

PROTEST: Any protest must be filed in writing accompanied by a \$50 payment to the show manager within 24hrs of the questionable event or action. The payment will be forfeited to process the claim regardless of outcome. Show Manager will process protest for resolution in a timely manner.

BAD CHECKS: There will be a \$35 penalty fee plus any bank charges incurred by NMQHA. NMQHA and AQHA rules will apply. Entries in future shows will not be accepted until check(s) are cleared.

Combined SR and JR Horse classes (All Ages) will go in the SR Horse slot ONLY with permission from all exhibitors and show management. For combined classes with patterns, the SR Horse or Select pattern will be used.
